

## OUR COVID-19 PLEDGE TO YOU

**At MBS Envision we strive to keep our facility health partners, patients, and employees safe during this pandemic by carefully monitoring and following the recommendations of the CDC and public health agencies in order to mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Here are some of the steps we have taken to ensure the health and safety of those we serve:**

- All MBS Envision team members have completed a mandated self-screening, agree to stay at home if they have any illness or symptoms and will be required to self-isolate for two weeks upon any potential direct exposure to COVID-19.
- Our team will comply with all facility screening policies and procedures, including completion of required temperature checks and screening questionnaires upon entry to your building.
- Our MBS Envision team brings our own PPE for use during studies including: masks, eye shields, and exam gloves.
- All MBS Envision x-ray equipment, x-ray vests, potential splash surfaces, medical tools, eye shields, and instruments are cleaned and disinfected between each patient procedure.
- The study supply cart and its contents will either be maintained a minimum of six feet away from the study area or left outside the study room if space does not allow.
- Our transportation van is fully cleaned and disinfected on a daily basis.
- We continue to follow our Infection Control Policy, including adherence to universal healthcare precautions. This includes proper hand washing before and after each study, use of disposable examination gloves, and use of masks and eye-shields.
- Facilities who self-identify as being “COVID-FREE” will be serviced at the beginning of each workday.
- When scheduling a facility with known or suspected COVID-19 cases, our Clinical Directors will personally screen the proposed study site to ensure proper physical isolation of our team from the isolation unit.
- For patients on additional isolation precautions (e.g. contact or droplet), the MBS Envision SLP and/or MBS Envision Physician Partner will ensure all team members are utilizing additional PPE needed as directed/provided by the facility.
